Job: Seaton Acres Drainage Improvement Project

Project Introduction

Existing drainage infrastructure in Seaton Acres consists of roadside ditches and driveway culverts.

The neighborhood is fairly flat along Bertram Road and McLeod Road and the existing outfall ditch is clogged, resulting in large amounts of ponding along and on top of the roads.

The ditches along Kendall Road become very deep with steep sides as they approach Snead Road.

The south end of Bertram Road and McLeod Road have curb and gutter along the road edge ending at the low point where this project area begins.
