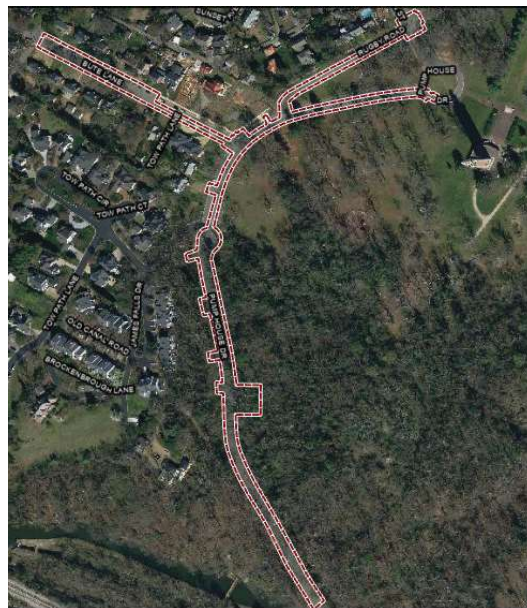
Job: Pump House Drive Drainage Improvement Project

Location: Portions of Wilbon Street, Rugby Road, Pump House Drive, and Bute Lane

Project Introduction

The Pump House Drive Drainage Improvement Project will address drainage issues along Rugby Road, Pump House Drive, and Bute Lane, including the installation of new storm drain inlets, piping, and new curb and gutters.

This work will also include the replacement of damaged curb and gutters, and the installation of ADA ramps at sidewalk intersections.

Project Assignment: Hazen and Sawyer

Survey & Preliminary Design: August 2019 through December 2019 (H&B Survey and Accumark)

Engineering Design: January 2020 through October 2020

Construction Assignment: Construction Currently Underway

The construction of this project has been assigned to an annual contractor.

Though the ability to purchase and procure reinforced concrete pipe delayed the originally anticipated project schedule, construction began in July 2021 and is anticipated to be completed in 2023.

Periodic road lane closures and occasional construction traffic can be expected as part of the Pump House Drive Drainage Improvement Project.
