Job: Wakefield Road Drainage Improvement Project

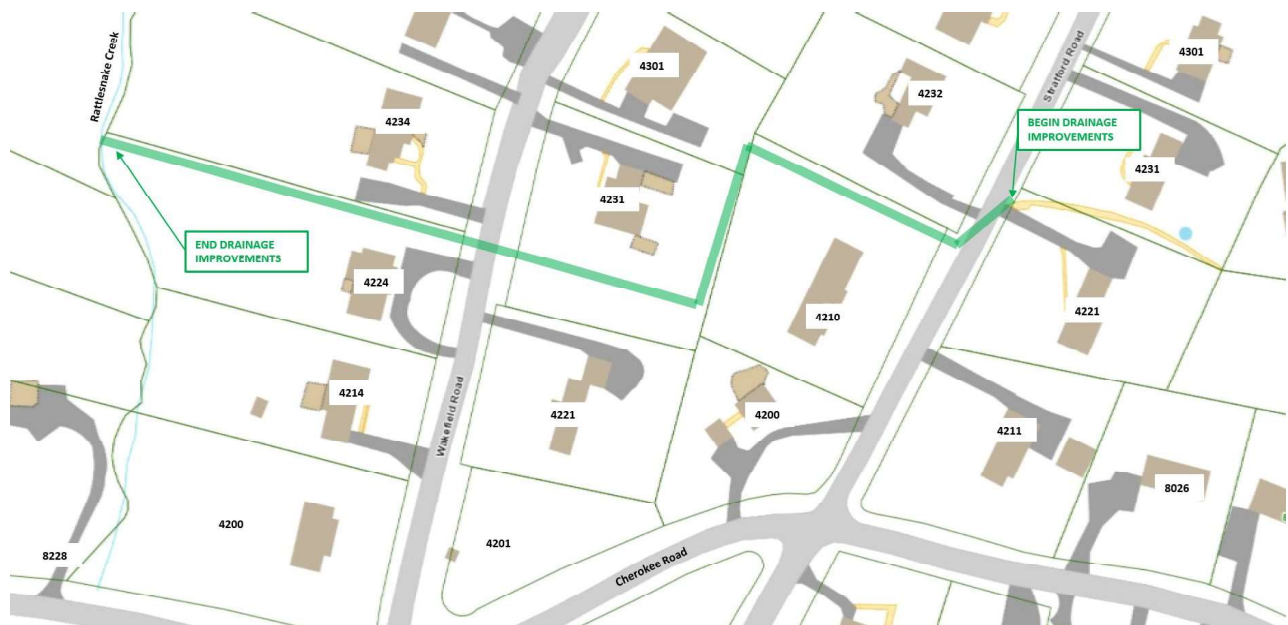
Location: Stratford Hills, between Wakefield Road and Stratford Road

Project Introduction

This project will address the severe erosion within the existing channel in the neighborhood's backyards and the consistent sediment buildup within the existing channel between Wakefield Road and Rattlesnake Creek. The project area is highlighted within the figure below.

The proposed improvements consist of:

- Approximately 1,000 linear feet of new storm drain pipe within the eroded swale between Stratford Road and Wakefield Road
- Replacement of the undersized culverts under Stafford Road and Wakefield Road
- Improvements to the existing channel between Wakefield Road and Rattlesnake Creek

Survey & Preliminary Design: Completed

Engineering Design: Completed (RK&K)

Construction Assignment: Construction Anticipated to Begin Mid-August 2022 (Estimated Length: 6 Months)

All necessary easements have been acquired for the project.

Project Duration:

Private utility relocation is complete.

The project design and environmental permit acquisition is complete.

Construction is anticipated to begin in August of 2022 and is anticipated to last approximately six (6) months.

Construction equipment will be in the neighborhood daily and periodic road closures can be expected as part of the Wakefield Road Drainage Improvement Project.
