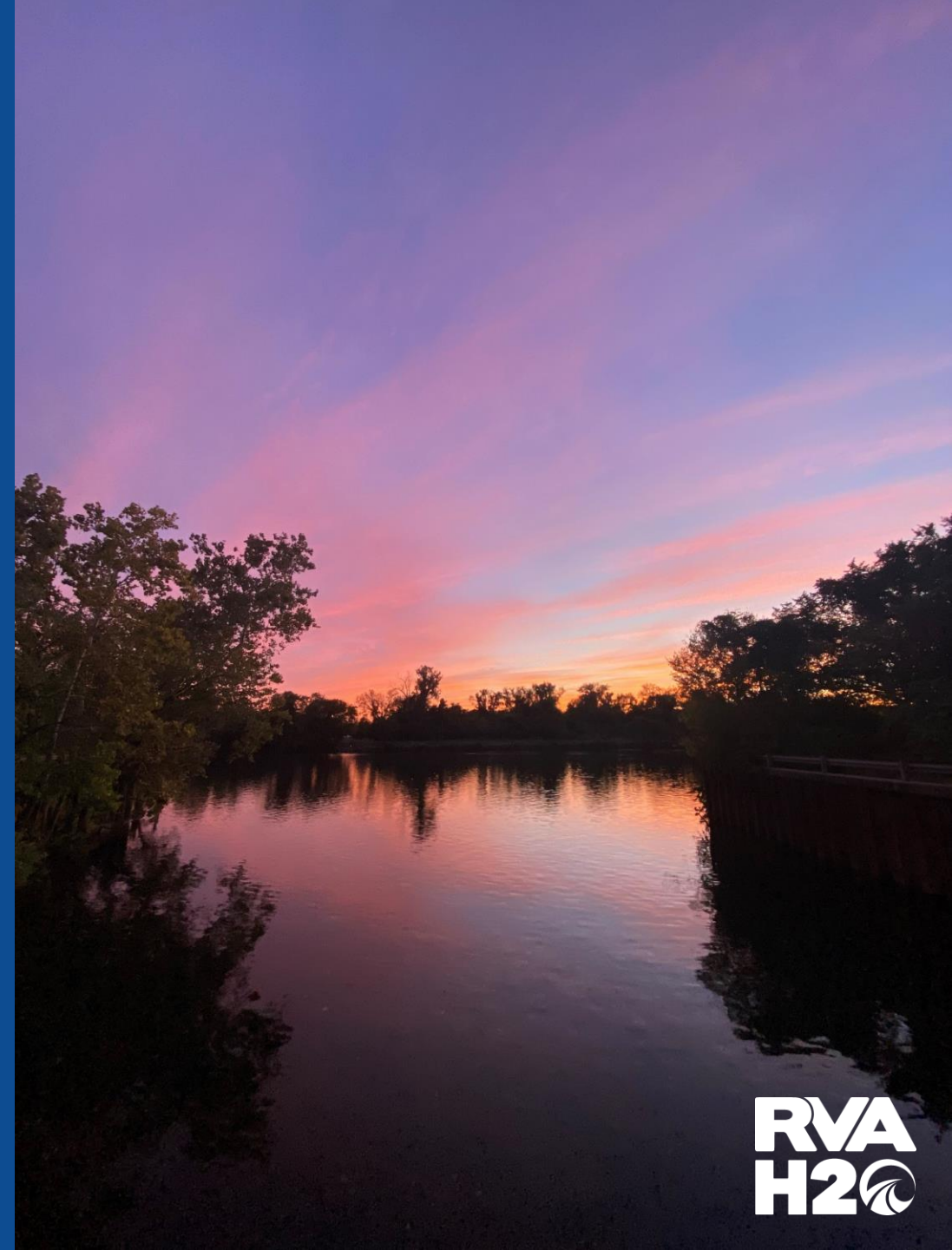

Project Purpose and Overview

What:

Installing a larger sewer pipe

Why:

Reduces combined sewer system overflows

Overflow Volume Reduction (MG)	5.1
Overflow Event Reduction (#)	48



Construction Timeline and Expected Impacts

When:

Construction Start: July/August 2023

Duration: 18 months

Traffic Impacts:

- Towards the end of construction
- On Williamsburg Road
- May last up to 6 months
- Drivers will have at least a month of notice
