

Richmond DPU: City Improvement Projects

Job: Byrd Park Maintenance Shop Project

Location: 2301 Amelia Street

Project Introduction

This project was completed in partnership with the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Community Facilities.

The Byrd Park Maintenance Shop had a large cave-in of the piped stormwater conveyance system around both sides of the drainage inlet at the southeast portion of the facility, inside of its fenced perimeter. The cave-in resulted in limited usable area at the Byrd Park Maintenance Shop for equipment and materials storage.

Project improvements occurred between Shields Lake Drive and Shields Lake. The project involved the installation of eight (8) drain inlets, an endwall, and 664' of pipe and also restored the park area, including improving the sidewalks around Shields Lake, reseeding the project area, and upgrades to the storage area at the Byrd Park Maintenance Shop.
