## Project Introduction

This effort involves field investigations on the ground in areas of Richmond's 9th City Council District to survey and study stormwater infrastructure and update the City's inventory of stormwater assets accordingly, including within the City's Geographic Information System (GIS).

Field investigations have thus far taken place within the three study areas outlined in the map below, including portions of the Worthington Farms, Warwick, South Garden, and Piney Knolls neighborhoods.

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# WHAT HAPPENS NEXT:

## Field Investigations:

Field investigations began in November of 2024 for the Stormwater Asset Inventory Project.

Survey work is being performed by VA Civil and Gannett Fleming.

Richmonders may notice vehicles and survey crews in neighborhoods collecting data, locating utilities, and investigating drainage conditions and concerns.

All survey personnel will wear safety equipment and carry appropriate identification.

At times, surveyors may need to access portions of private property within the project areas to collect survey information.

Bilingual notification letters have been sent to addresses within the study areas, and door hangers are also distributed in advance of the field investigations to inform neighborhoods of the activity.

We apologize for any inconvenience and greatly appreciate your partnership as these important investigations are completed.

## Community Flood Preparedness Fund:

This project has received state funding support from the Community Flood Preparedness Fund administered by the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) in the amount of \$1,495,548.00, an estimated 90% of the total project cost. Stormwater Utility is responsible for a \$166,172.00 10% match.

## Project Benefits:

The Stormwater Asset Inventory Project will better inform Stormwater Utility's Capital Improvement Program and operations staff.

The updated asset inventory and information this effort provides will offer an opportunity to gain new insights, further understanding of the existing stormwater infrastructure and drainage system, accurately record stormwater assets, and best serve the communities within the inventoried areas.
