Job: Seminary Avenue Emergency Repairs


Location: 3rd City Council District

Project Introduction

This project will repair stormwater infrastructure and a cavitation near the intersection of Seminary Avenue and Sherwood Avenue. The project area is indicated in orange on the graphic below.

Construction began on Wednesday, February 4th of 2026 and should be complete by the end of February, weather permitting. Final pavement restoration will follow in the spring when the weather is most cooperative.

Road and sidewalk closures along Seminary Avenue and Sherwood Avenue can be expected as part of these emergency repairs. Please refrain from parking in the construction area throughout the duration of this work. Temporary traffic control signs are in place to direct drivers and traffic accordingly.

Construction activity can be expected to occur between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm from Monday through Friday each week. Construction is expected to be complete by the end of February, weather permitting.

Final pavement restoration will occur in the Spring of 2026 when the weather and temperatures are most cooperative.

Road and sidewalk closures along Seminary Avenue and Sherwood Avenue can be expected as part of these emergency repairs.

Please refrain from parking in the construction area throughout the duration of this work.

Temporary traffic control signs are in place to direct drivers and traffic accordingly.

Construction vehicles and traffic can be expected in the project area during construction work hours.
