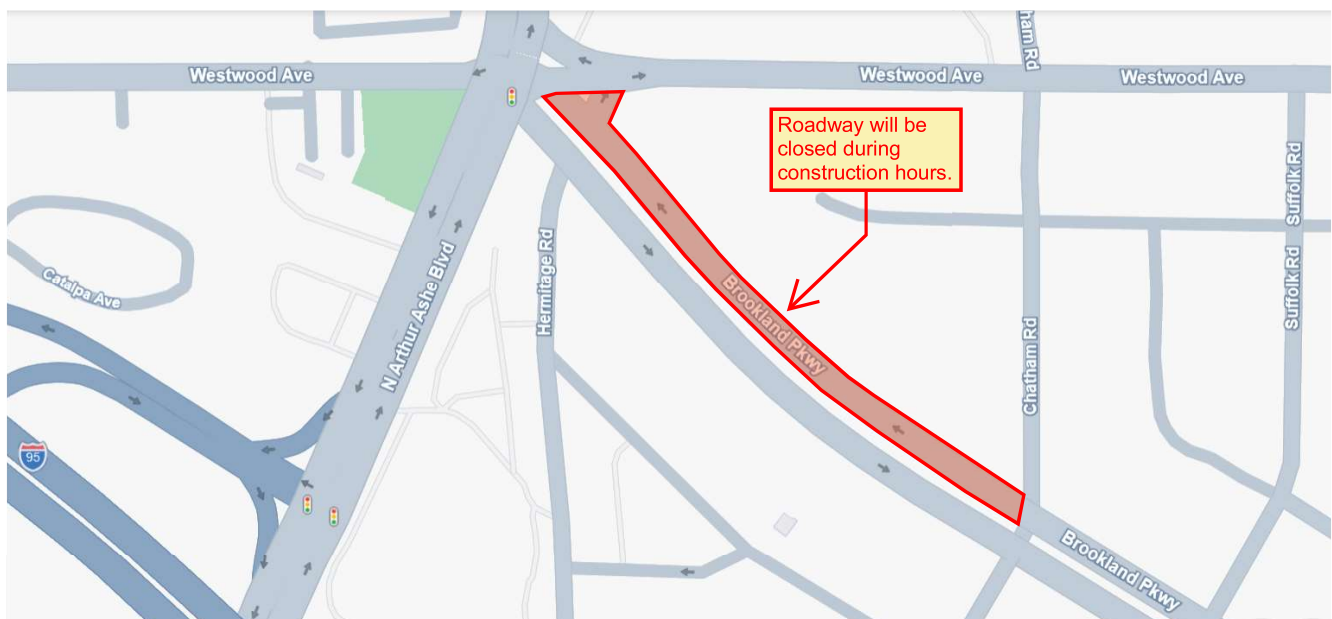
Job: Brookland Parkway Emergency Repairs - 1600 Block

Location: 3rd City Council District

Project Introduction

This emergency project will repair stormwater infrastructure and a cavitation in the 1600 block of Brookland Parkway. Construction is expected to begin on Monday, March 30th of 2026 and should be completed by Friday, April 10th or sooner, weather permitting. Construction hours will be 9:00 am to 4:00 pm from Monday through Friday each week.

The westbound lane, and bike lane, of Brookland Parkway will be closed to through traffic between Chatham Road and the intersection of Arthur Ashe Boulevard and Westwood Avenue during construction hours, as indicated in red on the graphic below. Temporary traffic control signs will be in place to direct drivers, traffic, and cyclists accordingly. Residents may enter via the road closure to access their homes. Residents are encouraged to avoid street parking during construction hours and to observe the "No Parking" signs until these important repairs are complete.

Project Duration:

These emergency repairs to address stormwater infrastructure will be completed by our contractor PB Chenault.

Construction is expected to begin on Monday, March 30th of 2026.

Construction activity can be expected to occur between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm from Monday through Friday each week.

The westbound lane, and bike lane, of the 1600 block of Brookland Parkway will be closed to through traffic between Chatham Road and the intersection of Arthur Ashe Boulevard and Westwood Avenue during construction hours.

Residents may enter via the road closure to access their homes.

Residents are encouraged to avoid street parking along the westbound lane of the 1600 block of Brookland Parkway during construction hours as it will be closed to through traffic.

Residents are also encouraged to observe the "No Parking" signs in the construction area.

Street parking on Chatham Road may be more convenient for residents.

Temporary traffic control signs will be in place to direct drivers, traffic, and cyclists accordingly.

Construction vehicles can be expected in the project area during construction work hours.

Construction is expected to be completed in two (2) weeks or sooner, weather permitting.

This flyer will be updated with additional information as the project progresses.
