

Richmond DPU: City Improvement Projects

Job: Mimosa Street Improvements

Location: 2100 Block of Mimosa Street

Project Introduction

This project will remove abandoned stormwater infrastructure from the 2100 block of Mimosa Street to eliminate cavitations and improve public safety. The scope of work will involve replacing driveway entrances, sidewalk, and a stormwater inlet. The project will also replace the asphalt curb with concrete curb on the north side of Mimosa Street between Willis Street and Minefee Street. Following the completion of this work, disturbed areas and surfaces will be restored with topsoil, seed, and straw, and any fences, driveways, and walkways will be replaced in kind as needed. The project area is highlighted in yellow on the graphic below.

Construction is expected to begin on Monday, April 6th of 2026 and is anticipated to last approximately two months, weather permitting. All affected residences and property owners will be notified prior to the start of construction.

Mimosa Street will be closed to thru traffic from Willis Street to Minefee Street during construction hours.

Temporary traffic control signs will be in place to direct drivers and traffic accordingly.

Construction vehicles can be expected in and through the neighborhood during construction work hours.

All affected residences and property owners will be notified prior to the start of construction.
