

# Richmond DPU: City Improvement Projects

**Job:** Glenan Drive Emergency Repairs - 3000 Block

**Location:** 8th City Council District

## Project Introduction

This maintenance project will repair a stormwater pipe failure in the permanent drainage easement between 3013 and 3019 Glenan Drive, shown in the map below. The project will include minor vegetation removal at the outfall, minor improvements at the outfall to minimize erosion, restoration activities within the permanent easement, and replacing a curb inlet within the area of disturbance on Glenan Drive.

The majority of this work will be within the permanent drainage easement. There will be minor traffic impacts throughout the project, including, during street work, road closures to through traffic. Local residents will be able to access their homes. "No Parking" signs will be in place and should be observed. Construction hours are 8:00 am through 5:00 pm Monday through Friday. The project is expected to take 10 weeks to complete, and began on Monday, April 20th.
