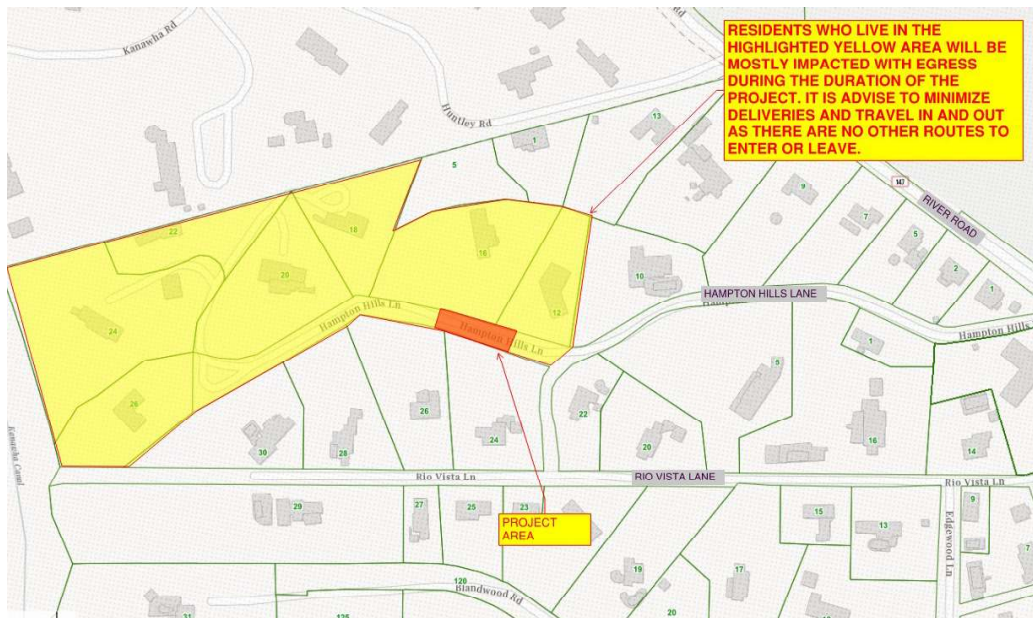
Job: Hampton Hills Lane Emergency Repairs

Location: 1st City Council District

Project Introduction

This project will repair a stormwater pipe failure near 12 Hampton Hills Lane and will involve the installation of a new stormwater pipe. All work will occur within the right of way, and minor vegetation removal will occur along the right of way to allow for installation and access.

Construction began on Tuesday, April 14th of 2026 and should be completed within 15 days, weather permitting. Hampton Hills Lane will be closed during construction hours due to a large open cut in the roadway needed for the installation of the stormwater pipe. This will impact all homeowners from Edgewood Lane to the end of Hampton Hills Lane. We advise minimizing deliveries and travel during construction hours throughout the anticipated 15 days of construction. Construction hours will be 9:00 am to 4:00 pm from Monday through Friday.

Project Duration:

This emergency project to repair and replace stormwater infrastructure will be completed by our contractor Tidewater Utility Construction Inc. (TUCI).

Construction began on Tuesday, April 14th of 2026.

Construction activity can be expected to occur between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm from Monday through Friday each week. Our contractor will attempt to complete work and reopen the roadway by 3:00 pm each day or will otherwise provide access for homeowners leaving for school pick up.

Construction is expected to be completed within 15 days, weather permitting.

Hampton Hills Lane will be closed during construction hours due to a large open cut in the roadway needed for the installation of the stormwater pipe. This will impact all homeowners from Edgewood Lane to the end of Hampton Hills Lane.

We advise minimizing deliveries and travel during construction hours throughout the anticipated 15 days of construction as Hampton Hills Lane will be closed near the intersection with Edgewood Lane.

Street parking will not be available in the project area during construction work hours.

Outside of construction hours, the roadway will be bridged with temporary plates to allow for access to and from homes on Hampton Hills Lane past Edgewood Lane.

Final pavement restoration will occur later in the Spring of 2026 when the weather is most cooperative.

Construction vehicles can be expected in the project area during construction work hours.
