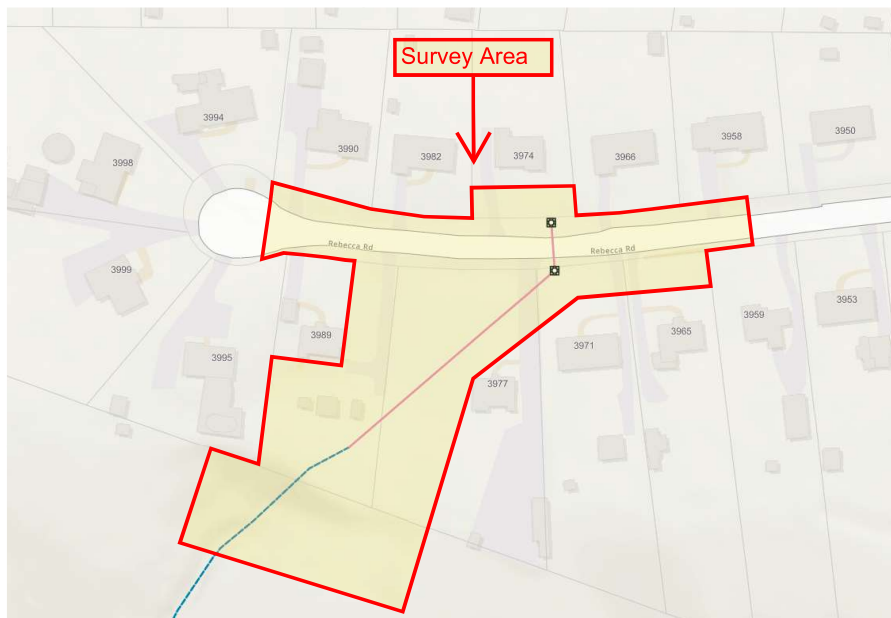
Job: Rebecca Road Drainage Improvement Project

Location: 8th City Council District

Project Introduction

The Rebecca Road Drainage Improvement Project will address failing stormwater infrastructure and cavitations in the 3900 block of Rebecca Road. The existing drainage system will be designed to be realigned and placed within an existing utility easement.

In preparation for the design this project, City staff, engineers, and surveyors will be in the project area for approximately three months beginning in early July of 2026 for the purpose of gathering necessary field data. All personnel will wear safety equipment and carry appropriate identification. Richmonders may see field personnel, survey crews, and vehicles within the project area collecting data, marking existing utilities, and performing field investigations. We are committed to minimizing any disruptions as much as possible. The survey area is outlined in red on the graphic below.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT:

Field Investigations:

The first phase of the Rebecca Road Drainage Improvement Project includes field investigations to collect information about the existing drainage conditions, topography, and infrastructure within the project area beginning in July of 2026.

H&B Surveying will be conducting topographic and property surveying.

Accumark will be conducting field surveys of underground utilities.

Drillers from Emerson Harper & Associates, LLC will be conducting geotechnical borings and performing test pits with a mini-excavator.

PipeVision will be performing dye testing and CCTV of the existing storm pipes.

Ecologists from RK&K will conduct a delineation of jurisdictional aquatic features.

All representatives will carry appropriate identification and wear safety equipment.

Though most of this work will be performed within the right-of-way, there may be instances where team members will need to access portions of private property to investigate drainage concerns and gather comprehensive information to best inform the Rebecca Road Drainage Improvement Project.

It is not necessary for property owners and/or residents to be present during any of these field investigations.

We are committed to minimizing any disruptions as much as possible.

We greatly appreciate your patience as this necessary data is gathered over the course of approximately three months in preparation for the design of the upcoming Rebecca Road Drainage Improvement Project.

Project Duration and Potential Easement Acquisitions:

Easement acquisitions may be necessary for this project to be constructed.

Project Benefits:
