Job: Mimosa Street Improvements

Location: 2100 Block of Mimosa Street

Project Introduction

This project removed abandoned stormwater infrastructure from the 2100 block of Mimosa Street to eliminate cavitations and improve public safety. The scope of work also involved replacing driveway entrances, sidewalks, a stormwater inlet, and the asphalt curb with concrete curb on the north side of Mimosa Street between Willis Street and Minefee Street.

Construction was completed in July of 2026. Several additional trees will be planted in the fall of 2026 when the weather is more favorable for their successful establishment.
